Lumpkin County Library Honored

The Lumpkin County Historical Society honored the Lumpkin County Library at a recent

meeting held on April 9. To correlate with Gold Rush Days this past October, our youth services specialist, Andrea Tucker, designed a program centered around pioneering skills for our Discovery Club, which is geared for grades six through eight. During the program, participants learned how and why cream turns into butter (with a special sample to share). The teens also made spindles to try hand spinning to see how and why wool sticks together when it is spun. Cotton handkerchiefs were tie-dyed with blueberries to replicate how pioneers used natural dyes to color fabric. The historical society presented

*Prize will be based on 10% of the gross profits up to \$500.








Georgia History Book Club Dawson County Library Wednesday, May 20, 2015 2:00 PM - 3:00 PM

bribery, wives hiring hit men and all sorts of other criminal debauchery. This event is sponsored by the Dawson County Friends of the Library. Light refreshments will be served.


Another Long, Hot Day *Dawson County Library* Saturday, May 09, 2015 11:00 AM




