# Inventory of the Benjamin P. Gaillard Collection

#### **Overview of Collection**

**Abstract:** The Benjamin P. Gaillard Collection contains documents and materials belonging or pertaining to the Benjamin Palmer Gaillard family, dating from 1877 – 1937. The collection contains: Benjamin P. Gaillard's journals; ledgers pertinent to college courses, religion, and financial information; a telegram to Benjamin P. Gaillard, and a promissory note with the Bank of Lumpkin County. Also included in this collection are: the Gaillard Family Bible containing copied pages listing family births, deaths and marriages; and a bound book given to Benjamin P. Gaillard in 1923 entitled Messages from Friends that contains letters written by students celebrating his fiftieth year teaching at the North Georgia Agricultural College.

#### **Biographical Sketch**

Benjamin Palmer Gaillard was born in South Carolina on October 28, 1850, to Reverend Savage Smith Gaillard and Sarah Jeanette Crosson Gaillard. Benjamin Palmer Gaillard married Martha "Mattie" Jane Boyd on June 28, 1877 in Lumpkin County, Georgia. Mattie Jane Boyd was born in 1854 to Colonel Weir Boyd and Sarah Jane Sitton Boyd. Benjamin and Mattie Gaillard had seven children, six of whom survived to adulthood.

Benjamin Gaillard graduated from Oglethorpe University with a Bachelor of Arts in 1872. After graduating he became a professor at the North Georgia College in 1873 where he continued to teach for over sixty years. Over his lifetime, he earned additional degrees, including an A.M. degree at the University of Georgia and a Ph.D. from Oglethorpe University. At North Georgia College, Benjamin Gaillard was a professor of mathematics from 1873 to 1876, head of the Latin department from 1876 to 1886, and head of the science department until 1932. Dr. Gaillard was the vice president of the college from 1896 to 1922. Dr. Gaillard also studied the weather and was the dean of the co-operative observers for the Weather Bureau in Georgia from 1892 until his death in 1938.

Benjamin Palmer Gaillard died on December 20, 1938, at Downey's Hospital in Gainesville, Georgia at the age of 88. He is buried in the Mount Hope Cemetery in Dahlonega, Georgia. The above biographical information was abstracted from materials located in the Genealogy and Historical Vertical Files and the Family Files which are housed at the Lumpkin County Library.

#### **Scope and Content Note**

The bulk of the collection consists of Benjamin P. Gaillard's personal diaries from 1910 until 1937, one year before his death. Several ledgers, also written by Benjamin P. Gaillard, contain information pertinent to college courses, religion, and financial information, with a date range of 1906 - 1915. A telegram to Benjamin P. Gaillard, and a promissory note with the Bank of Lumpkin County are also in this collection. Also included in this collection is the Gaillard family Bible, given to Benjamin P. and Mattie B. Gaillard on December 25, 1877. With the Bible is a copy of the pages listing family births, deaths, and marriages. Lastly, the bound book entitled Messages from Friends contains letters written by alumni in honor of Professor Benjamin Gaillard's 50<sup>th</sup> year as a teacher at North Georgia College.

Anthony shortly before her death in 1989. The Gaillard Family Bible and the Messages from Friends bound book were given to the Lumpkin County Library by the Lumpkin County Historical Society in 2016. Earlier that year, the Bible and book had been donated to the Lumpkin County Historical Society by Georgia Eiss of Rockford, Illinois after she discovered them in her mother's home. Georgia and her husband Bob traveled to Dahlonega in May 2016 to donate these two items to the Historical Society.
